Requirements

The Town of Wickenburg requires the Mayor and Council Members to be:

- ⇒ Eligible to Vote and Registered to Vote in the Town *
- ⇒ Cannot hold any other public office that in any way conflicts with the office of the Mayor or Council Member *
- ⇒ Residents of Wickenburg, or in an area annexed to Wickenburg, for one year preceding the date of election or appointment to office *

Optional Requirements include:

- ⇒ Enjoy paperwork, research, reading, long hours and hard work *
- ⇒ Support from family and friends *
- ⇒ Good sense of humor *

* Before and after elected

Candidate Packets Available in Town Clerk's Office:	January 14, 2020
Candidate Filing Deadline:	April 6, 2020*
Close of Voter Registration (Primary):	July 6, 2020*
Primary Election:	August 4, 2020*
Close of Voter Registration (General):	October 5, 2020*
General Election:	November 3, 2020*
New Council Seated:	December 7, 2020*

* Dates may change as the result of changes in State law.
